NARRATIVE

On January 31st, 2026, deputies responded to 2065 US Highway 321 North in reference to a report of inmates fighting. Upon arrival, deputies detained Thomas Johnson and began investigating the incident. I then spoke with the victim, Edgar Humphrey, who stated that he and Thomas Johnson had been involved in a verbal argument regarding dogs at the facility. Edgar Humphrey advised that Thomas Johnson became upset during the argument, went inside the Animal Care Center, and retrieved a shovel. Humphrey stated that Johnson then came back outside and swung the shovel at him twice, striking him once on the top of the head. Humphrey advised that he fell to the ground and observed blood coming from his head. He stated that other inmates intervened and separated the two, after which he proceeded inside the Animal Care Center office with another inmate, Lauren Moore. I, Corporal Banas, observed a visible cut on the top of Edgar Humphrey's head, with blood dripping down the side of his head and onto his left ear. The injury was photographed, and Edgar Humphrey

stated that he did wish to press charges.

Deputies then spoke with witnesses Lauren Moore and Torbert Mack, who both stated that Edgar Humphrey and Thomas Johnson were involved in a verbal argument in the parking lot outside the Animal Care Center. Both witnesses advised that Thomas Johnson entered the Animal Care Center and returned outside with a shovel. Torbert Mack stated that he attempted to stop Johnson and talk him out of his actions but did not intervene further because he did not want to be struck by the shovel. Both witnesses stated that Thomas Johnson swung the shovel at Edgar Humphrey twice, striking him once and knocking him to the ground, before Lauren Moore escorted Humphrey into the

NARRATIVE

Animal Care Center office. Deputies then spoke with Thomas Johnson, who stated that he observed Edgar Humphrey and Lauren Moore spraying dogs with water in an attempt to make them fight and that he made them stop. Johnson stated that Edgar Humphrey told him, "wait until we get back to the dorm," which prompted Johnson to retrieve the shovel because he believed a confrontation would occur. Johnson admitted to striking Edgar Humphrey with the shovel.

Deputies also spoke with Neely Thomason, the head of the Animal Shelter, who stated that she was inside her office when she heard an argument in the parking lot. Thomasson advised that she went outside and observed Thomas Johnson holding a shovel while Edgar Humphrey was on the ground bleeding from the head. Thomason stated that she returned inside to call for assistance and that Edgar Humphrey followed her inside. EMS arrived on scene and evaluated Edgar Humphrey before transporting him to MUSC Fairfield for further evaluation. Due to Humphrey being in custody, he was escorted to the hospital by Joey Price and another Fairfield County Detention Officer. Thomas Johnson was transported back to the Fairfield County Detention Center, and a warrant will be sought for Assault and Battery, 2nd Degree. Hospital staff later provided discharge paperwork indicating that Edgar Humphrey received staples to his scalp, which are to be removed in one week. Deputies then cleared the scene. Nothing further to report at this time.
